


#ContraceptionChecklist resource pack



Introduction



Contraception helps to prevent unwanted pregnancies. There are many different methods of contraception from long-acting reversible methods such as coils (IUS/IUDs) to condoms.

Everyone is different and not every contraception option will suit all. This campaign is aimed at raising awareness of the different methods available, enabling individuals to make an informed decision as to their choice.

The designs are based on feedback from our service users, and other members of our local community, which highlighted the want of a contraception checklist to help inform their contraception choice.
